- A. <u>Energy flow</u> moves through a community as producers and consumers interact
  - 1. <u>Food chain</u> how food energy moves from one organism to another

 Food webs – overlapping food chains to better show the way energy moves through an ecosystem 3. <u>Ecological pyramids</u> – bottom layer of pyramid represents ecosystem producers, top layers represent consumers

4. Energy pyramid – compares the energy available at each level of a food chain' bottom levels have more energy than top levels

B. Cycles of matter – matter that makes up living organisms, such as water, carbon, and nitrogen, recycled through the environment

1. Processes of evaporation, condensation, and precipitation make up the <u>water cycle</u>

 Carbon, nitrogen phosphorus, sulfur and other elements needed by living organisms move through Earth's <u>other</u> <u>cycles of nature</u>. • The Food Chain
