1. Amount of land is <u>limited</u>

2. People must use land wisely

a. Preserve <u>natural habitats</u>

4. Forest – <u>nonrenewable</u> resource – complex ecosystem

C. Minerals – land resource found in rocks

1. Ore – mineral mined at a profit

a. Found under Earth's surface

b. Metals – such as iron

2. Mining – process used to reach ore

a. Moves large quantities of soil and rock

b. Affects the environment
